If you have followed us for any length of time you know those phrases characterize our investment in people where ever we've been.

The nine years that Pam battled cancer did not sideline us. Our community changed but we continued to live a spiritually vital life next door to those dying of cancer. We saw fruit and we saw multiplication.

You know even from my one of my [last letters](#) that Awn and I are among the people here in Thailand. We do not minister TO a target audience we live among our friends and neighbors. We engage young, old, monks and community leaders within the social fabric of everyday life. We live and disciple right among the people of many beliefs and backgrounds.

This is why we have been invited to Cyprus. Will you help us contribute there?
